

Health Insurance in Wisconsin: Progress and Potential Impact

The uninsured rate has been dropping since the implementation of major Affordable Care Act provisions. Wisconsin has seen a significant drop, however further improvement could be realized if BadgerCare+ was expanded to adults under 138% of the federal poverty level.

Total Uninsured Rate in Wisconsin 2008-2015




The Uninsured in 2015



All races saw large declines in uninsured rates, but minorities still lag behind whites


Percent of Wisconsin population without health insurance by race, 2013 and 2015
