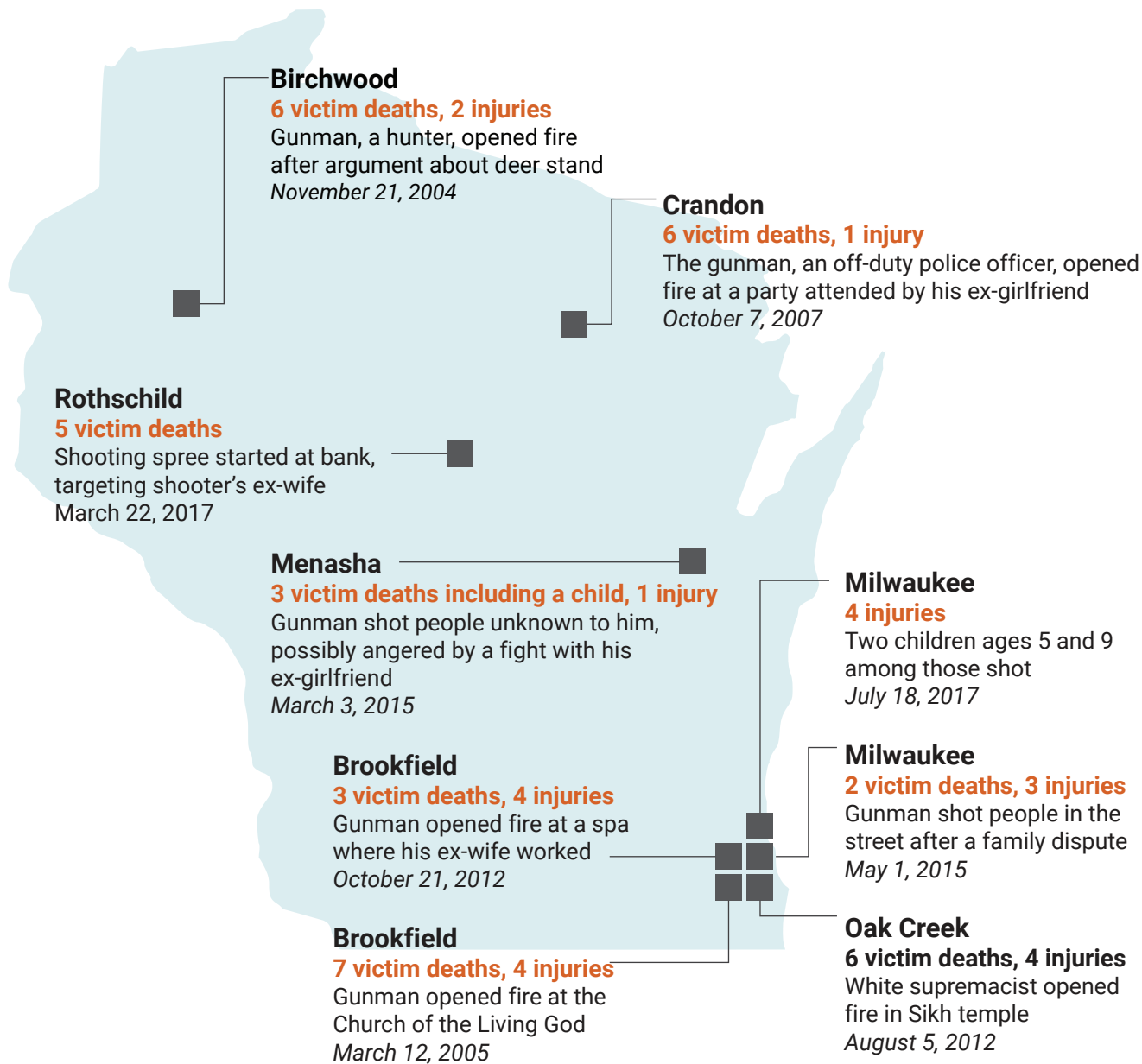


# It Happens Here Too: Mass Shootings In Wisconsin
