For each additional person, add \$1.93/hour for families at 100% of poverty.

Significance of poverty levels for health insurance eligibility in Wisconsin:

- 100% = The new maximum income limit for parents and childless adults to be eligible for BadgerCare, and the minimum income limit to be eligible for financial assistance in the Marketplace.
- 138% = The income level that all states had the *option* of expanding Medicaid to with significantly enhanced federal Medicaid funding. (Wisconsin did *not* choose to expand Medicaid to this limit.)
- 200% = The income starting point to charge premiums for children enrolled in BadgerCare.
- 250% = The maximum income to be eligible for federal **cost-sharing assistance** (help paying for co-pays and deductibles) for insurance plans obtained through the Marketplace.
- 300% = The maximum income limit for children to be eligible for BadgerCare.
- 400% = The maximum income to be eligible for federal **premium assistance** for insurance plans obtained through the Marketplace. (People at all income levels are eligible to purchase insurance through Marketplace without financial assistance).

Note: The poverty level figures will all be adjusted upwards in 2014 (typically in February)
